- On Friday evening, I had a presentation for families via Zoom to review our schoolwide academic data. I plan on scheduling another evening at the end of the month for families that were unable to attend last week. More information to come regarding date/time. I will post on class Dojo.
- A reminder to please check Dojo for upcoming events and school wide communication. All communication goes through class Dojo as well as my monthly newsletters. Please reach out if you have any questions/feedback.
- We are currently interviewing for a part -time community Liaison. Interviews took place today and a couple more candidates will be interviewed later this week. We are still looking for a part-time "Response to Intervention" teacher (RTI). The RTI position provides literacy and/or math support for students in need of Tier II interventions. If you know of anyone, please refer them to the TUSS D jobs website to apply. The position is 20 hours per week.
- In the coming months, I will receive our Title 1 and Magnet budget for the 2024 -2025 school year. Once received, I will review with our site leadership team to determine the allocations for next school year. Our site leadership team is comprised of three classroom teachers, magnet coordinator and CSP. I am committed to financial transparency and working with our site

leadership team to determine how the funds will be used. Budget decisions will be shared with the site council and families as well. More info to come.

- We are excited to announce that we will have a pilot bike club beginning this month for 3rd - 5th graders. The organization is "El Grupo" Students will participate on Wednesdays after school.
