- Motion to make a line item for Posadas - Cruz Seconds. We also support Community Liaison to make hot chocolate and gather cookies, we get donations and it would be good to have some funds to use. A new thing we learned also, is that Community Liaison is not allowed to ask for donations.
- Clare motion to add a line item for Cesar Chavez March. Cruz Seconds. We will also need to get permits and barricades.
